Supplies:

- **Stamps:** Elephant Parade (158695); Trees for Sale (159785)
- **Card Stock:** Basic White (159276); Evening Evergreen (155574); Soft Succulent (155776); Crumb Cake (120953); Crushed Curry (131199); Mossy Meadow (133676); Silver Foil 12"x12" (156457); Vellum (101856); In Color 6" x 6" Designer Series Asst – 2021-2023 (159254)
- **Stamp Pads:** Soft Succulent (155778); Evening Evergreen (1155576);
- **Misc:** Tree Lot Dies (159938); Stylish Shapes Dies (159183); Timber 3D Embossing Folder (156406) Dimensionals (104430); Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653); Stampin' Seal (152813)

Measurements:

- Evening Evergreen: 4 ¼" x 11", scored at 5 ½". 4" x 5 ¼" and scrap for tree
- Soft Succulent: 2 ¾" x 4 1/8"
- Basic White: 2 5/8" x 4"
- Crumb Cake: 1 ¼" x 4"
- DSP: 3/8" x 4"
- Silver Foil: 2" x 3"
- Mossy Meadow: scrap for tree
- Crushed Curry: scrap for curtain
- Vellum: ¾" x 2"

Instructions:

1. Emboss Evening Evergreen Layer with Timber 3D folder and adhere to card base with dimensionals.

2. Stamp 1 Large and 2 Medium detail trees on Basic White cardstock in Evening Evergreen ink. Stamp corresponding solid tree stamps in Soft Succulent ink. Ink greeting on the bottom in Evening Evergreen ink.
3. Adhere Basic White Layer to Soft Succulent cardstock and then to card base.
4. Die cut the Crumb Cake card stock with largest banner die from the Stylish Shapes dies.
5. Die cut Silver Foil, Crushed Curry, Mossy Meadow, and Evening Evergreen with the camper, curtain, large tree detail and large tree solid dies from the Tree Lot die set.
6. Adhere Tree die cuts to the Basic White Cardstock.
7. Banner ends of the DSP and adhere to the Crumb Cake banner. Adhere to the Basic White Cardstock, just above greeting.
8. Adhere curtain and vellum cardstock to the back side of the camper image and adhere camper to Basic White Cardstock with dimensionals.

Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets**-Trees For Sale (159785)
- **Card Stock** –Cherry Cobbler (119685), Festive Foils (159536), Evening Evergreen (155574), Basic White (159276), Parakeet Party (159259), Silver Foil (156457)
- **Ink**-Cherry Cobbler (147083), Parakeet Party (159259), Evening Evergreen (155576), Soft Succulent (155778), Soft Suede (147115),
- **Misc**- Tree Lot Dies (159938), Stampin' Dimensionals (104430), Stapler.

Measurements:

- Cherry Cobbler: 4 1/4" x 11" scored at 2 1/8" from bottom and 3 3/8" from top (card base), scrap for bow die.
- Evening Evergreen: 1 7/8" x 4" plus small scrap for wreath die.
- Festive Foils: 3 1/8" x 4" -green foil, 1" x 3"-red foil, 3/4" x 2"-yellow foil
- Silver Foil-2' x 3"
- Parakeet Party-1 1/4" x 1 3/4" for small tree die
- Basic White scraps for tree base die and "Trees for Sale" sign die.

Instructions:

1. Take Cherry Cobbler piece and fold down top and fold bottom up. Staple in the middle of the bottom to secure bottom half (cardbase).

2. Die cut all pieces. Camper out of Silver Foil, Camper top and bottom out of Red Foil, Wreath out of Evening Evergreen and Bow out of Cherry Cobbler.
3. Stamp 5 Tree bases in Soft Suede on Green Foil. And stamp one tree base on Basic White scrap. Then Stamp 3 large trees in Soft Succulent and 3 large detail trees in Evening Evergreen on top. Then Stamp 2 medium trees in Parakeet Party and 2 medium detail trees in Evening Evergreen. See picture for placement.
4. Stamp small tree detail in Evening Evergreen on Parakeet Party scrap. Then stamp sign in Soft Suede on Basic White scrap.
5. Die cut Sign, small tree, and tree base.
6. Glue Green Foil on top of card, centered. Glue Evening Evergreen piece to bottom of card.
7. Glue Red Foil die piece on top and bottom of Camper, Wreath to door and Bow to bottom of Wreath. Then glue yellow foil to back of Camper.
8. Adhere Camper to bottom half of card with 3 dimensionals on bottom of Camper overlapping where top and bottom meets.
9. Glue tree base and tree to bottom left of card. Adhere sign to top of card with dimensional. Top of card should fold under Camper. This is called a Matchbook card.
