

Apple Harvest



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Supplies:

- **Stamps** – Apple Harvest (159944)
- **Card Stock** – Basic Black (121045); Basic White (159276); Granny Apple Green (146990)
- **Stamp Pads** – Tuxedo Black Memento Ink (132708)
- **Stampin' Blends** – Granny Apple Green (154885); Polished Pink (155520); Petal Pink (154893); Soft Suede (154906); Color Lifter (144608)
- **Misc.** – Celebrate Everything Designer Series Paper (159913); 2021-2023 In Color Opal Rounds (159185); Apple Blossom Dies (160255); Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653);

Measurements:

- Granny Apple Green: 4¼" x 11"; scrap for die cutting
- Basic Black: 2½" x 4"; 4" x 5¼"; 3½" x 3½"
- Basic White: 3¾" x 5"; scrap for stamping & die cutting
- Designer Series Paper (DSP): 2¼" x 3¾"; 1" x 3¾"

Instructions:

1. Score card base at 2¾" & 5½"; fold in z-fold
2. Layer Basic Black and DSP; adhere to left side flap of card base.

3. Stamp sentiment on Basic White with Memento Ink. Adhere DSP to right side. Adhere to Basic Black and then to card base.
4. Adhere Basic Black to Granny Apple Green. Adhere the left side to the left flap.
5. Stamp apples on scrap Basic White with Memento Ink. Color with blends.
 - a. Granny Apple Green for leaves and apples
 - b. Soft Suede for branch
 - c. Polished Pink for flower centers and Petal Pink for flower petals (lightly brush).
 - d. Use color lifter as needed to soften Polished Pink
6. Die cut with Apple Blossom Dies & adhere with dimensionals to the card front.
7. Die cut two small leaves and one large leaf from Granny Apple Green.
8. Die cut two small flowers and one large flower from Basic White. Add light brushstrokes of Petal Pink to the flower petals.
9. Adhere one large and one small leaf to die cut apples with mini glue dots.
10. Adhere large flower to front with mini glue dots. Add opal round to middle and to bottom left corner.
11. Layer both smaller flowers with glue dots and adhere with glue dot to the inside of the card.
12. Tuck the small leaf under the stacked flowers with mini glue dot.

- **Card Stock:** Basic White (159276); Granny Apple Green (146990); Pale Papaya (155668)
- **Stamp Pads:** Tuxedo Black Memento (132708); Versamark (102283)
- **Stampin' Blends:** Granny Apple Green (154885); Crumb Cake (154882); So Saffron (149557); Daffodil Delight (154883); Pale Papaya (155519)
- **Misc:** Brick & Mortar 3D Embossing Folder (149643); Pale Papaya 3/8" Open Weave Ribbon (155672); Basics Embossing Powders (155554); Heat Tool (129053); Paper Snips (103579); Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755); Stampin' Dimensionals (104430); Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653)

Measurements:

- Granny Apple Green: 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" scored at 4-1/4"
- Granny Apple Green: 1 3/4" x 3/4"
- Basic White: 3 1/2" x 4"
- Pale Papaya: 4" x 5 1/4"

Instructions:

1. Fold the Granny Apple Green cardstock in half to form card base.
2. Emboss the Pale Papaya using the Brick & Mortar 3D Embossing Folder and the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine.
3. Glue the embossed piece to the card base.
4. Stamp the apples on Basic White using Memento Black ink.
5. Colour the image using the Stampin' Blends.
6. Cut out the image with the Paper Snips.
7. Glue a piece of ribbon to the back of the image folding it in three and pop up the piece on the Pale Papaya using Stampin' Dimensionals.
8. Stamp the sentiment in Versamark on the Granny Apple Green, apply Black Emboss Powder and heat set.
9. Pop up the sentiment on the card using Stampin' Dimensionals.
