Supplies:

- Stamp Sets: Trimming the Tree Bundle (162522)
- Cardstock: Basic White Thick (159229), Basic White (159276), Real Red (102482), Garden Green (102584)
- Ink: Real Red (147084), Garden Green (147089)
- Tools & Accessories: Tree Trimming Dies (160256), Gold Foil (132622), Red Rhinestones (146924), Painted Christmas Designer Series Paper (156292)

Measurements:

- Card Base: Thick Basic White 5 ½" X 8 ½" score at 4 ¼"
- Cardstock #2: Painted Christmas Designer Series Paper 4 ¼" X 5 ½"
- Cardstock #3: Real Red cardstock ¾" X 4 ¼"
- Cardstock #4: Painted Christmas Designer Series Paper 2 ¼" X 5"
- Cardstock #5: Gold Foil 2 ¾" X 3"
- Cardstock #6: Garden Green cardstock: 2" X 3"
- Cardstock #7: Basic White cardstock: 1" X 2 ½"

Instructions:

- Score your card base and fold in half.
- Attach the Painted Christmas Designer Series Paper #2 to your card front.
- Take the Painted Christmas Designer Series Paper #4 and cut up from the bottom and from the sides creating the banner piece.
- Attach the Real Red cardstock #3 to the backside as shown and attach to your card front.
- Die cut the Gold Foil #5 with the tree pot, bows, star and label dies.
- Die cut the Garden Green cardstock #6 with the Christmas Tree Die shown.

- On the Basic White cardstock #7 stamp your sentiment using Real Red ink.
- Die cut out with the label die shown.
- Attach to the Gold Foil label die cut and attach to your card front using dimensionals.
- Attach the Tree Pot, Christmas Tree, and star to your card front using dimensionals.
- Attach the Gold Bows to your Tree using mini glue dots.
- Attach the Red Rhinestones to the bows as shown.
- On the inside of your card stamp the more solid Christmas Tree image using Garden Green ink by **stamping off onto scratch paper first** and then inside your card and then stamp the more intricate Christmas Tree image using full strength Garden Green ink.
