Measurements:


- Basic Black: 9-1/2" x 3"; 3-1/2" x 2-1/2"
- Pumpkin Pie Designer Series Paper (found in the 6"x6" Regals DSP pack): 3-1/4" x 2-1/4"; 2-1/4" x 1-1/4"; 1-1/4" x 1-1/4"; 2-1/4" (2 pieces
- Basic White: small scraps

Instructions:

- 1. Score the long piece of cardstock to create the base of the box. Place the cardstock vertically onto your Simply Scored Board, and score the entire vertical length at 1-1/2"; Turn the piece so that it's horizontal on your board. Score at 1-1/2"; 4"; 5-1/2" & 8". *Diagram at bottom of directions
- 2. Hold your cardstock so that it's horizontal, and cut the score lines at the bottom from the bottom of the cardstock up to the center line. These are the flaps for the bottom of the box.
- 3. Fold along all of the score lines, and use a bone folder to create crisp folds. Wrap the ends together, and attach the two ends together with Tear & Tape Adhesive. Fold the flaps to create the bottom of the box, and adhere using the same adhesive.

- 4. Using your Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine and the appropriate die from the Basic Borders set, die cut one short edge of the Basic Black rectangle. Use Stampin' Seal to attach it to the back of the box, and the small rectangle & squares to the front and side of the box.
- 5. Use the Memento ink to stamp 2 spiders, and the word 'Boo' onto scrap Basic White cardstock. Die cut the spiders with the coordinating die, and hand trim the word. Attach the word to the bottom right corner of the front of the box.
- 6. Cut two short pieces of black Baker's Twine. Determine the placement of the spiders on the large piece of DSP. Use a glue dot to attach the twine to the front, underneath the spiders. Use glue dots to attach each to the back of the paper.
- 7. Attach the DSP to the to the inside of the box, and the back rectangle. Attach the spiders to the box with Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 8. Cut 16" of gingham ribbon. Wrap it around the box, and tie in a bow. You may find it helpful to attach the ribbon to the back and sides of the box with glue dots before tying in a bow.
- 9. Add candy (Ghirardelli squares in photo) and give to friends!

Score on the blue lines at the measurements shown. Once scored, cut on the blue score lines BELOW



the center line. These are the flaps for the box bottom.

Bewitching

- Misc. –Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755), Paper Trimmer (159392), Paper Snips (103579), 1/8" Metallic Ribbon Parakeet Party (159196), Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653), Seasonal Labels Dies (156299), Layering Circles Dies (151770), Stampin' Dimensionals (104430), Peekaboo Treat Bags (159252), Blackberry Bliss (154877), Parakeet Party (159220), Light Cajun Craze (154879), Dark Daffodil Delight (154883) Stampin' Blends, Wink of Stella Clear Glitter Brush (141897), candy

Measurements:

- Gold & Rose Gold Paper 2" x 4"
- Basic White CS 3" x 3" for stamping witch shoes and die-cutting with Circles Dies; small piece for stamping "best witches"
- Fresh Freesia CS 2" x 4" for die-cutting label
- Blackberry Bliss CS scrap for punching 3 small stars
- DSP Perfectly Penciled 1" x 4", Design A Daydream (purple with lines) 1/2" x 4"
- Ribbon 10"

Instructions:

- 1. Using Liquid Glue, add Gold or Rose Gold strip to bag, lining up bottom with top of clear part of bag.
- 2. Adhere DSP layers to bottom of bag using Liquid Glue.
- 3. Stamp witch's shoes in Smoky Slate Ink and color with Blackberry Bliss and Parakeet Party Blends. Put Wink of Stella on colored buckles. Die-cut using Circles Dies. Attach to left side of bag using Liquid Glue.
- 4. Stamp witch's hat in Smoky Slate Ink. Color with Cajun and Daffodil Blends to create a goldish color. Put Wink of Stella on top of buckle to further blend colors. Fill in lines on hat using Blackberry Bliss Blends.
- 5. Attach hat on top of sock using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 6. Tie ribbon around bag twice and finish with a knot. Fray ribbon ends.
- 7. Using black ink, stamp sentiment onto scrap white piece and trim closely using Paper Snips.
- 8. Using largest label die from Seasonal Labels and Freesia paper, cut out and adhere sentiment on top using Liquid Glue. Attach behind hat using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- **9.** Punch out 3 small stars from Blackberry Bliss CS and adhere to right side of bag using Liquid Glue.
- **10.** Fill bag with candy of your choice.
